- **3 Ensure reliable communication methods.** As you contact various agencies, you'll learn that some are better at communicating than others. Choose an agency with quick and straightforward communication habits.
- **4** Protect against accidents with adequate liability insurance. Make sure that the agency is fully insured and bonded, and that it holds liability insurance.
- 5 Make sure your care plan will adjust to changing needs. Even once the care plan is implemented, a provider should have a method of evaluating that plan and adjusting it in the future to suit your parent or loved one's changing needs.
